Created to help members and attenders in Monthly Meetings throughout New England visit the West Bank and Israel, the Isaacs-Rawitscher Memorial Travel Fund provided three grants in 2023 for Friends from Burlington, Cambridge, and Hanover meetings.

From now to the end of 2025, the Fund will partially subsidize expenses for Friends while they travel in the military-occupied West Bank. There is a cap of \$1000 on each travel grant.
